High Frequency Words: I am little big up down

are red yellow blue

Phonics Exploration: (initial/ending sounds, blends, decoding)

p, b - blue, big, up k/c - cork r - red

s - sad, sun, small, stuff

or - cork ow - down

decoding: sad, mad, stuff, up, down, sun, red, apple

<u>Foundations</u>: feelings, size, high frequency words, colors, position, letter sounds (see phonics above), decoding, patterns – look closely and see what you can find!

<u>Inquiry</u>: What are you? Why? What do you want to be? Why? What words in the book describe feelings we have? Why?
